## CALHOUN AND LIBERTY COUNTY SURGE CONTINUES IN COMMUNITY REPORTED COVID-19 CASES

The Department of Health in Calhoun and Liberty County (DOH-Calhoun/Liberty) is informing the public that COVID-19 cases continued to increase the past week. Community spread has contributed to this surge. As of July 2nd, 97 cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Calhoun County and 238 cases have been reported in Liberty County.

DOH-Calhoun/Liberty is conducting contact tracing and working on identifying and notifying individuals who will need to self-monitor for symptoms for a 14-day period. Contact investigations are a critical way for staff epidemiologists to track and prevent the spread of disease. To assist DOH-Calhoun/Liberty in contact tracing the public can help by notifying your close contacts as soon as you receive positive results from your provider.

DOH-Calhoun/Liberty is focused on containing the spread of the virus. We are currently distributing cloth masks to residents. In addition, DOH-Calhoun/Liberty has expanded testing dates for the month of July. - Thursday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 3:00-5:30, CDT, Ramsey's Cash Saver, Blountstown
